



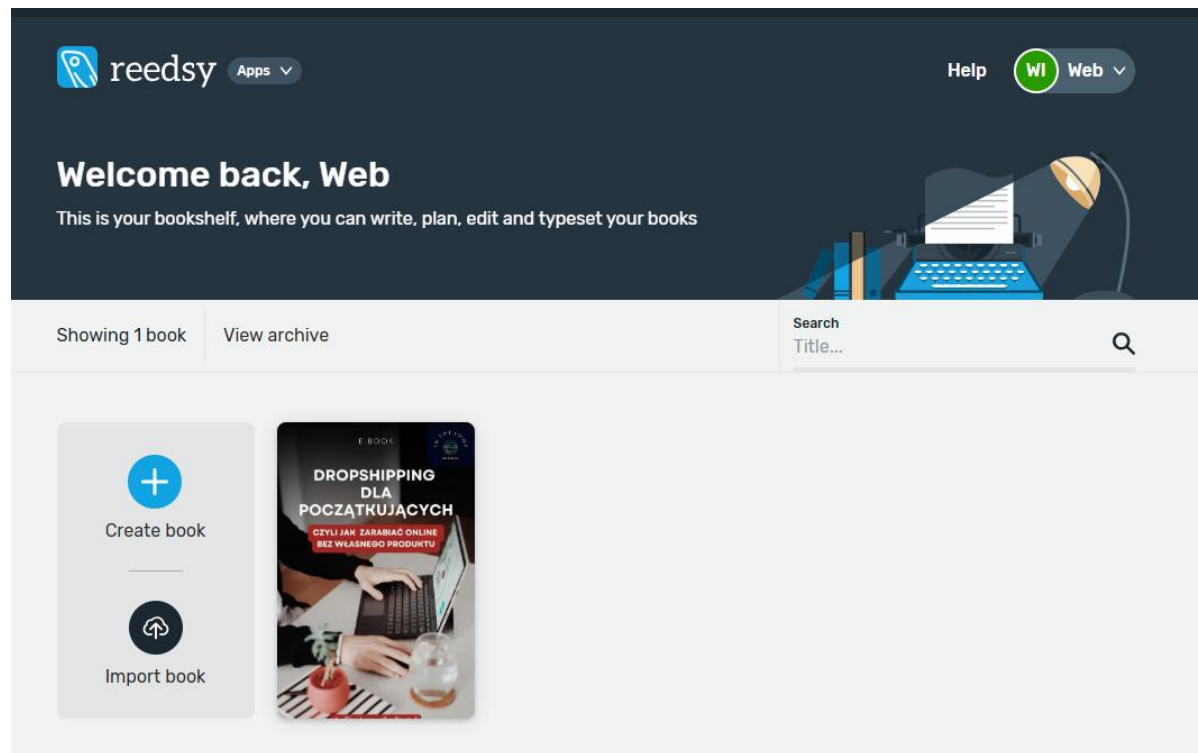
How to export your eBook in three different formats, using the eBook typesetting program 'Reedsy': PDF, EPUB and DOCX

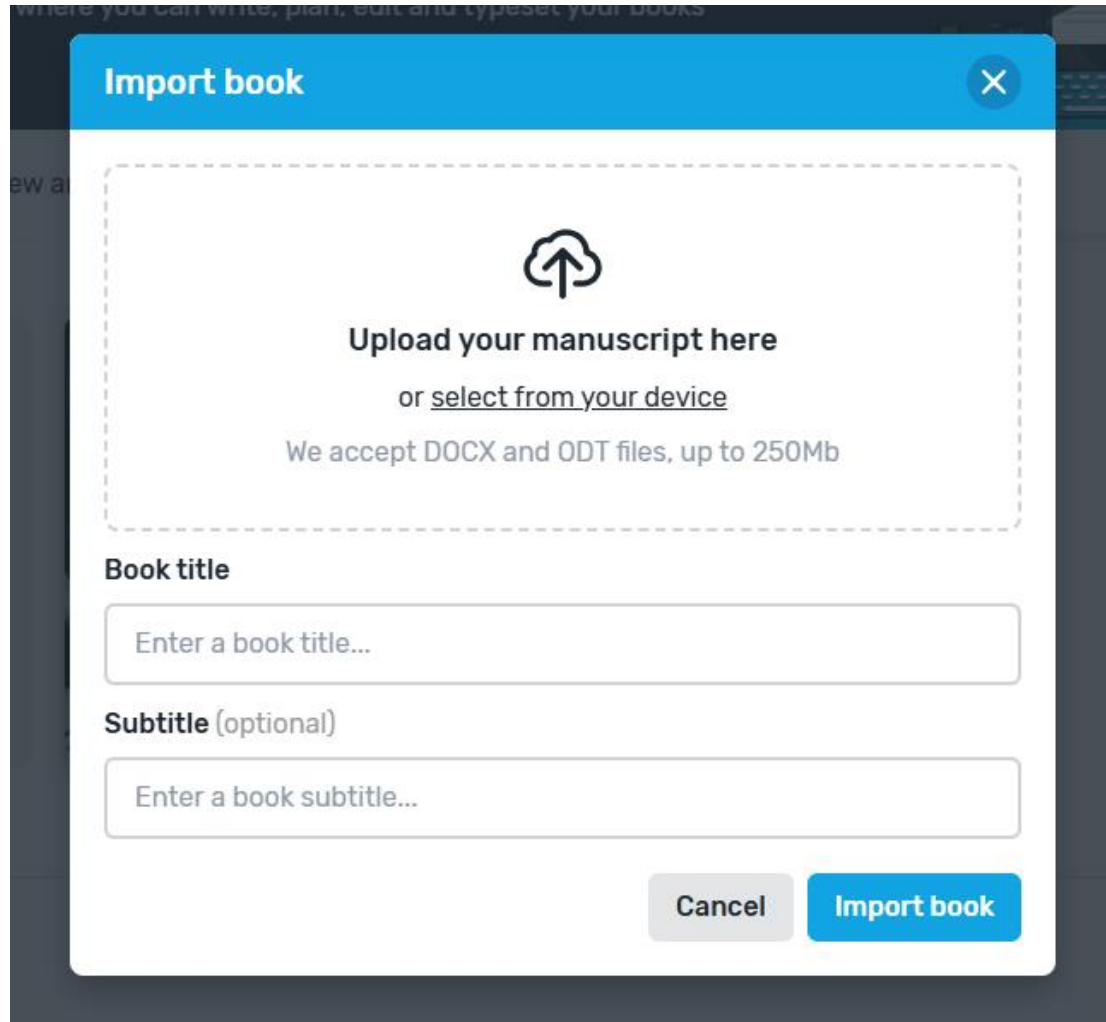
To export your eBook, you must first import it on the website <https://editor.reedsy.com/>.

We have two options: create a book directly in the cloud,
or import your file in the correct format:

Once we have our file ready and we can upload it,
we use the 'Import book' option – the formats that this tool accepts are given below:

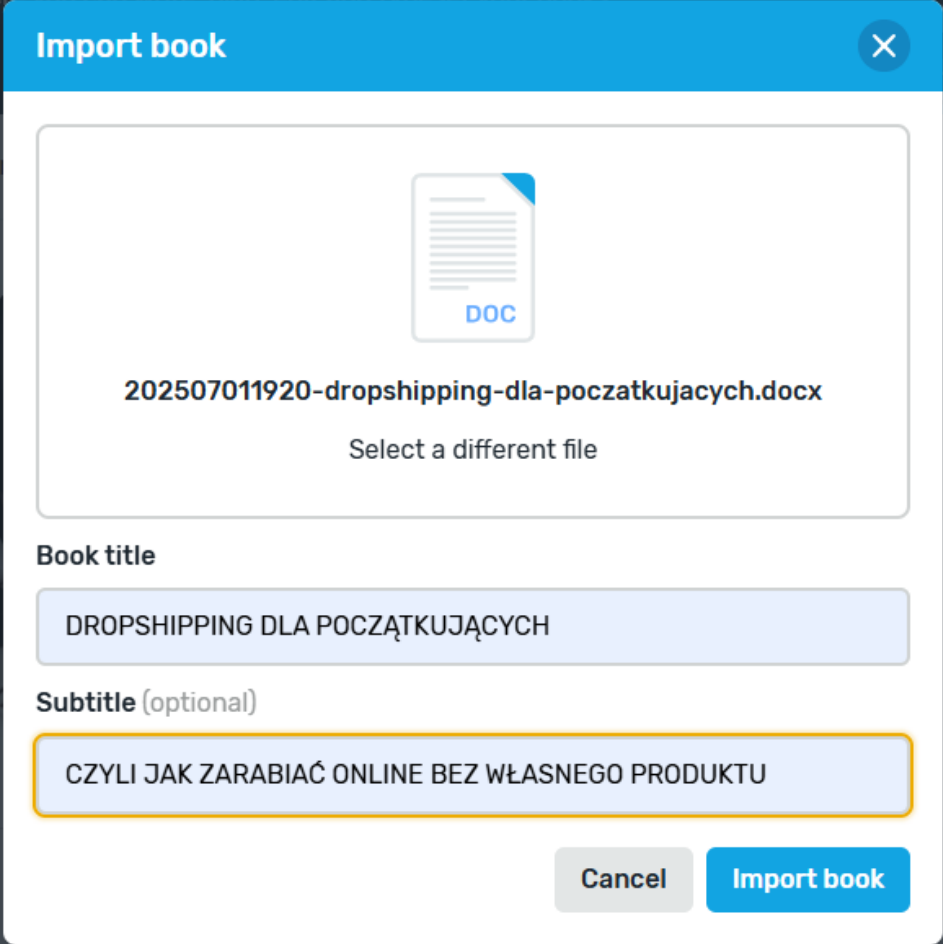

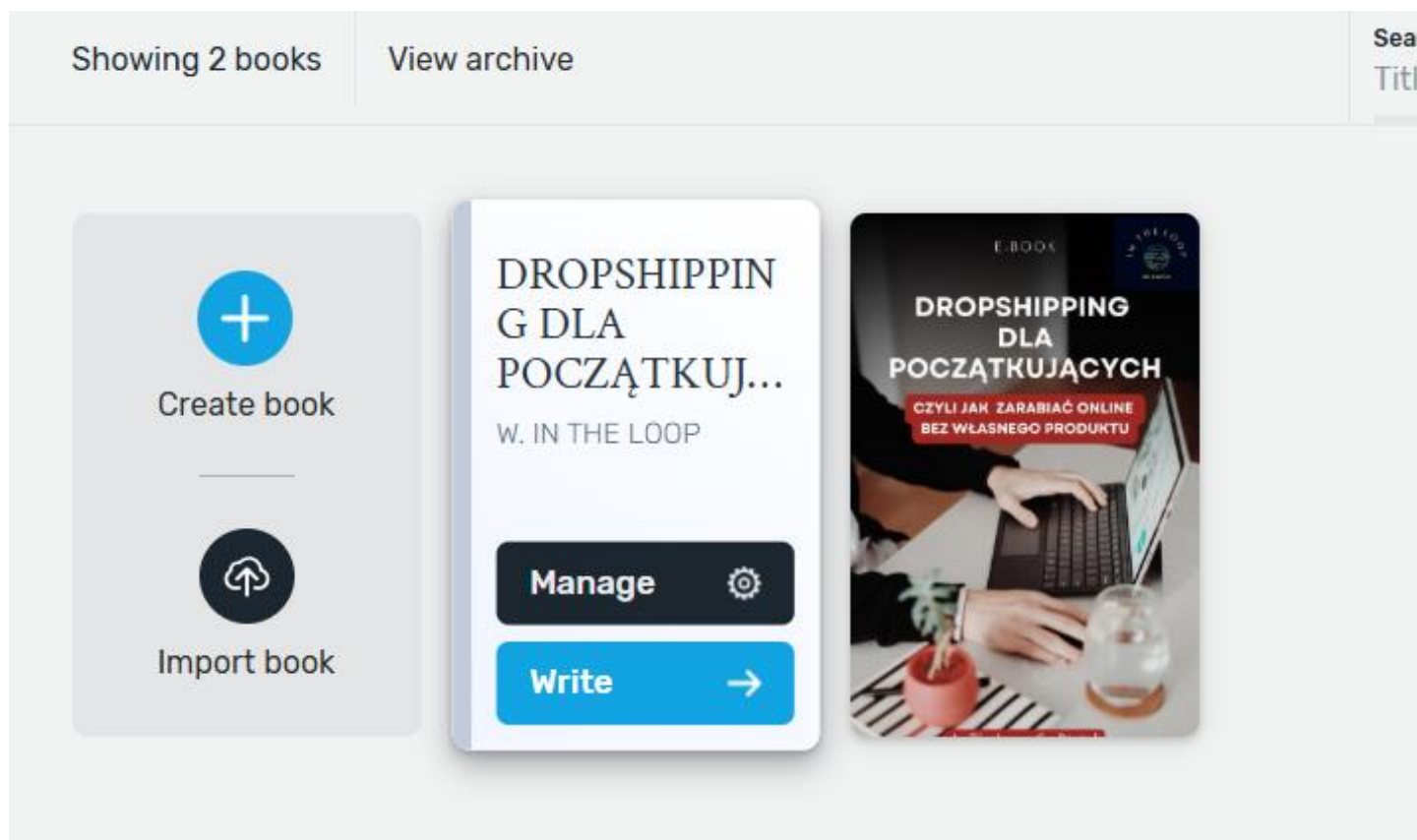

By clicking 'Write' we have the option to work on individual sections, divide into chapters, add information about the author, etc.

Great, so we have our digital product imported. Now we move on to instructions on how to export it in three different formats, which this tool offers:



After clicking the export icon, we get these options to choose from - I don't suggest any, because it depends on your preferences and needs. We can export:

- PDF

- EPUB

- DOCX

(to keep an editable Word copy of the eBook document).

An important thing is 'Trim sizes' - here you should check what format the platform you intend to upload your eBook to accepts.

In the case of my eBook, I used the Trade version (6" x 9"),
available after expanding the menu to adapt to the format proposed by Amazon:

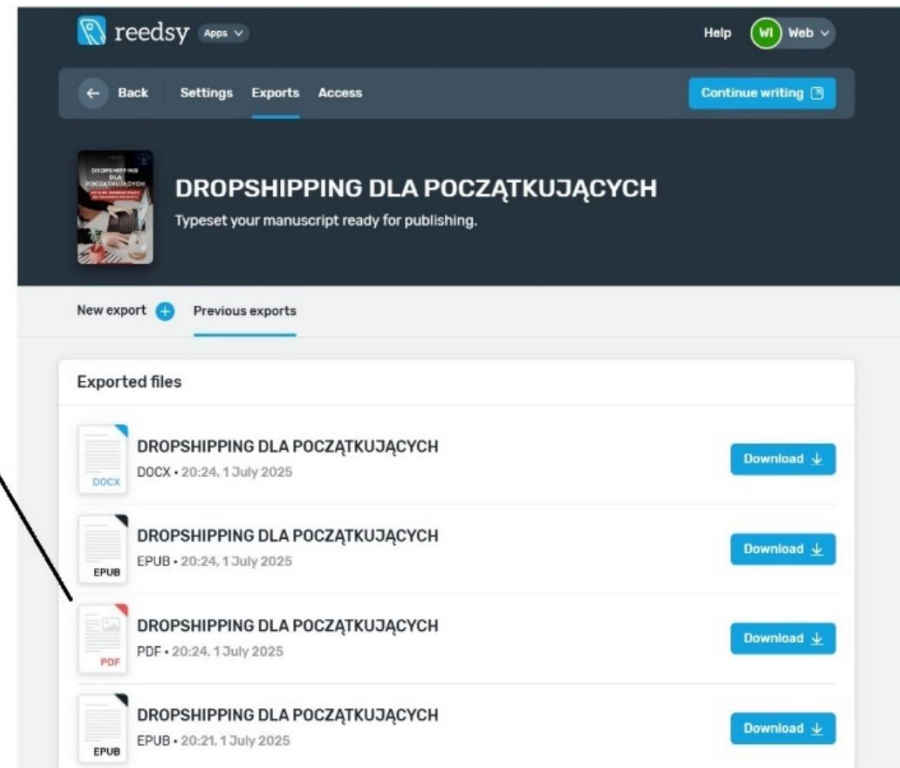
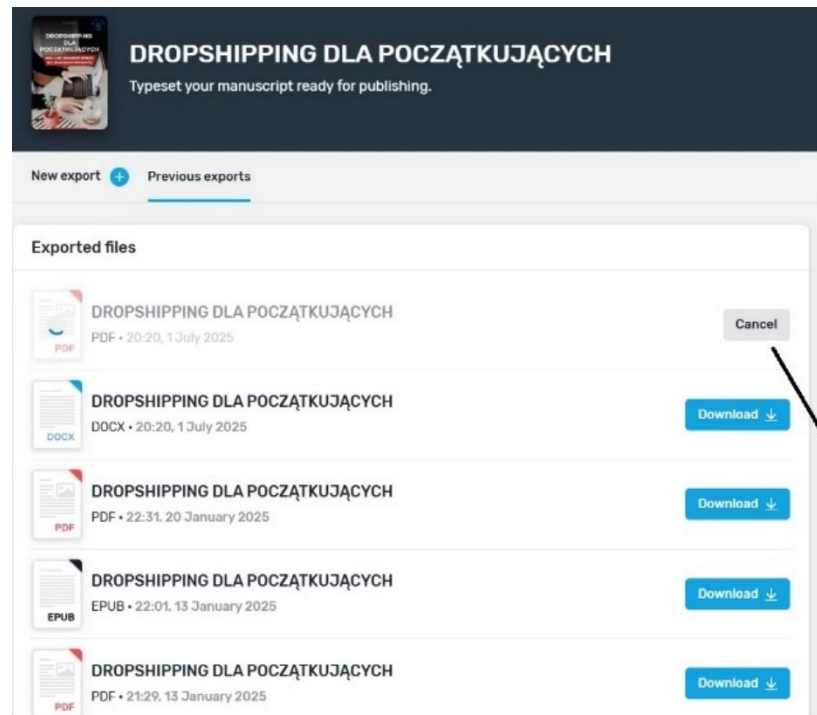

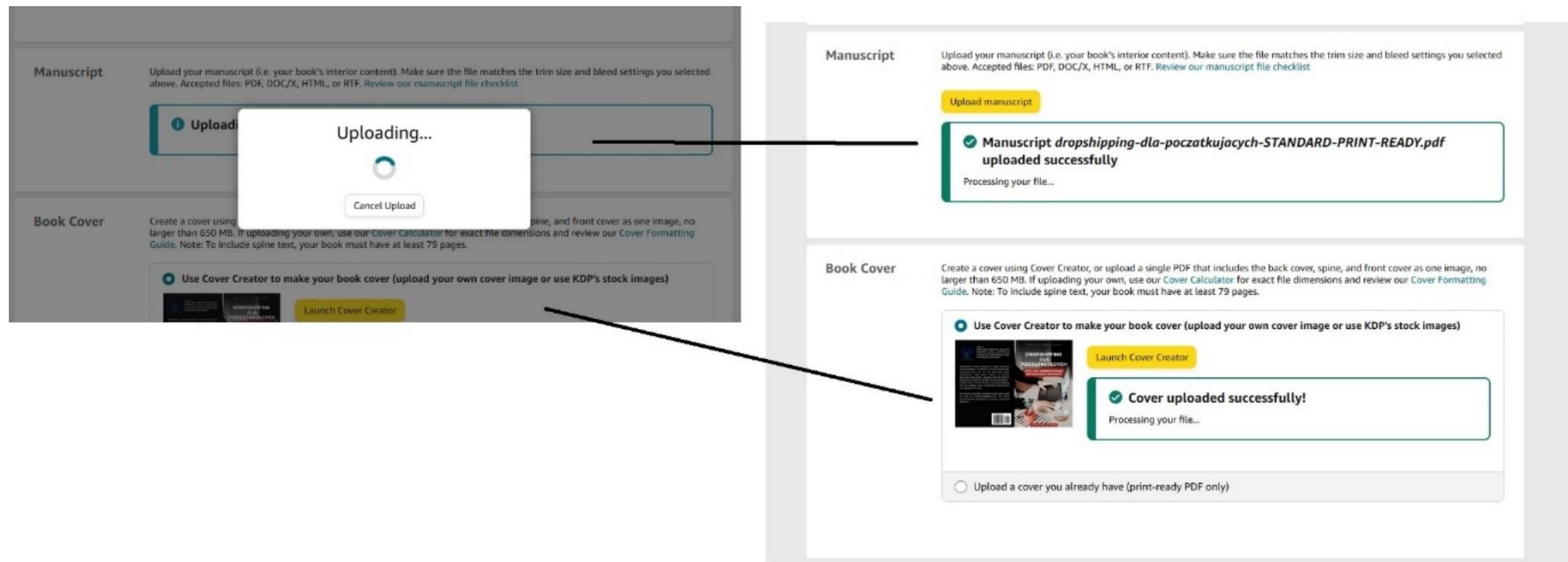

Next I exported the file in the selected format and repeated the same for the other two formats (EPUB and DOCX) – all three files can now be downloaded to your device:

***As for the cover, I recommend creating a design in e.g. Canva (where you can also choose the right size) and uploading it directly to Amazon KDP in the 'Cover' section, because Amazon does not require an uploaded eBook file with a cover. Instead, it gives you the option to upload the text and cover separately, which is quite convenient, because if you want to make changes to only one of these sections, you don't have to upload the whole thing again.**
